



Southeast Asia's Largest Gathering of Coffee, Tea and Bakery Industries : A Roaring Success!

March 5, 2016, Singapore: The fourth edition of *Café Asia 2016* and *International Coffee & Tea Industry Expo 2016* (ICT Expo 2016) and the third edition of *Sweets & Bakes Asia 2016* concluded on a high note for the organizer and exhibitors of the shows. A total of with 11,000 trade and public visitors packed the exhibition hall at Marina Bay Sands Expo and Convention Centre over three days from 3 to 5 March 2016.

The annual event is the largest gathering of players from the coffee, tea and bakery industries in the region. The show which played host to 140 exhibitors from 20 countries, including Brazil, Kenya and Costa Rica, showcased products, equipment and raw materials and opportunities for new collaborations for the industry.

Café Asia 2016 and ICT Expo 2016 have also become an important hub for the many talented young artisans in the industry who are actively pursuing their dreams and harnessing their creativity as baristas, brewers or latte artists. The crowds at Café Asia 2016 were thrilled by the competitors of the four national coffee championships,

Singapore National Brewer's Cup 2016, Singapore National Barista Championship 2016, Singapore National Latte Art Championship 2016 and the Singapore Cup Tasters Championship 2016. The winner of the respective national championships will represent Singapore at the World Brewer's Cup (WBrC) 2016, the World Barista Championship 2016 to be held in Dublin, Ireland, and the World Latte Art Championship 2016 and the World Cup Tasters Championship to be held in Shanghai, China.

- Regina Tay won the Singapore National Barista Championship 2016;
- Jervis Tan of Kinsmen Coffee won the Singapore National Latte Art Championship 2016;
- Will Leow of Knockhouse Supply Co. won the **Singapore National Cup Tasters Championship 2016.**

Visitors to the shows were also treated to the mouth-watering presentations by talented bakers who participated in the **Singapore Bakery & Confectionery Championship 2016.** Organized by the Singapore Bakery & Confectionery Trade Association (SBCTA), the competition recognized baking talents and celebrated the creativity and innovation of Singapore's professional and student bakers. In the Bread category, **Chan Wen Yung** of Crown Bakery Pte Ltd emerged as this year's champion while **Khong Jia Ming and Syahir Osman**, the team from SHATEC took the top spot in the Cake category.
